## **AUSTRALIA: 2011 WILUNA TO PERTH, WA**

Australia has over 30% of world uranium reserves and is facing an unprecedented uranium mining expansion. This walk will begin from a proposed uranium mine site - the first step in this destructive industry. Come and listen to the Indigenous people who will be directly affected by this mine.

## **CANADA: 2012 SASKATCHEWAN TO MONTREAL**

Canada is the largest supplier of uranium to the world. The largest uranium mine is McArthur River, Northern Saskatchewan. This long walk will visit and hear from First Nation and others on the impact of uranium mining and nuclear power.

## **USA: 2013 MINNESOTA TO BUFFALO, NY**

This walk will visit many nuclear facilities situated on the Great Lakes and major river system. We will finish at the West Valley nuclear waste site in Buffalo that is upstream from many Indigenous communities.

## **USA: 2014 MIAMI TO OAK RIDGE, TN**

This walk will connect the nuclear issue with the militarization of space and the current push for new nuclear reactors. We will finish at Y12 nuclear weapons facility that was part of the Manhattan Project and is still making weapons of mass destruction.

## **USA & JAPAN: 2015 OAKRIDGE, TN TO HIROSHIMA**

Starting from Y12 nuclear weapons facility this walk will visit many nuclear reactors including 3 Mile Island. We will arrive in Hiroshima on August 6th to remember the 70th year since the bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki.
