Subject: Request for information regarding the use of the containment spray at Oyster Creek on July 17, 2007

As discussed with Mr. Silverman, Citizens note from event notification report 43495 that containment spray was used at Oyster Creek on July 17, 2007. Citizens believe that the containment spray system could cause significant amounts of water to enter the concrete floor on the interior of the drywell, potentially disturbing the pH levels and the concentrations of impurities in contact with the interior drywell shell.

In order to assess these issues Citizens request AmerGen and the NRC to supply all information available on:

- i) the volume of water sprayed into the drywell during the event (in the absence of volume information, please supply as much information as possible on the magnitude and duration of the flow);
- ii) the volume of water that drained from the drywell during the event and thereafter until drywell drain flow returned to normal levels (again, in the absence of volume information, please supply as much information as possible on the magnitude and duration of the flow);
- iii) the chemical composition of the containment spray water;
- iv) the source of the containment spray water;
- v) the results of any sampling conducted in the trenches in the interior floor in Bays 5 and 17 after the event;
- vi) the results of any visual observation of the trenches in the interior floor in Bays 5 and 17 after the event;
- vii) any assessment that has been carried out of the potential for use of the containment spray to accelerate interior corrosion.

In order to avoid any scheduling difficulties, I request a prompt response to this request.
