Bill McKibben, 350.org, on nuclear power as a climate "solution:"

"I don't foresee, especially post-Fukushima, a kind of political system in most of the world that would let it happen. Even before Fukushima, it wasn't happening. The reason basically had to do with cost. Environmentalists helped shut down nuclear power, but really it was Wall Street that pulled the plug on it. It's too expensive. It's like burning \$20 bills to generate electricity. It requires, if you're going to do it, massive government subsidy. If you're going to apply that subsidy, you're better off doing it with other things that will generate more kilowatt hours per buck." October 2012.
