3. <u>Health/Safety/Environmental Impacts of Long-Term Waste Storage</u> - AGNM EC-ii (formerly AGNM b)

AGNM -- 15 minutes

LES -- 10 minutes

Staff -- 5 minutes

Additionally, the Licensing Board notes that it does not anticipate that the participants

will use the time allotted for argument on Group 6 given there is no opposition to admission of

the contention in that group.
